

**NAME**

tally – determines character counts of files

**SYNOPSIS**

**tally** [ **-l** ] [ **-b** ] [ file ... ]

**DESCRIPTION**

*Tally* gives a frequency list of ASCII and UTF-8 characters for each file mentioned. ASCII (one byte) characters over 126 are printed in a meta-notation; UTF-8 characters are shown as they are.

The **l**-option suppresses alphanumeric characters to be listed.

The **b**-option causes the program to ignore the UTF-8 property and to tally the bytes separately.
